STAY, PLAY & LEARN

Prenatal-6 years



Stay, Play and Learn allows opportunities for caregivers and families to take part with their children in a wide range of early learning inquiry based activities which enhance children's developmental skills.



BABY & ME

0-12 months

Join other parents and their babies from birth to 12 months to meet in an informal, supportive environment. Each week a topic of interest is presented along with songs and stories.

We ask that parents/caregivers actively support their child(ren) while in attendance.

DEVELOPMENTAL SCREENINGS

If you have questions or concerns about your child's speech and language or development in general, you can call your local EarlyON to have an ERIK Screening completed by one of our team members. This simple questionnaire with you does not require your child to be present, and can be done either in person or over the phone in about 15 minutes. The results of this screening can then be sent off to Royal Victoria Hospital (RVH) where their intake team will then contact you.

You can also visit www.lookseechecklist.com to monitor and check your child's developmental milestones by age. Should you have any questions, call your local EarlyON for assistance.
